It was also an important commodity of the Kampong Glam community, especially with the textile merchants of Arab Street. Let Mr Hafiz Rashid take you on a fascinating walk and talk about batik.

Join heritage enthusiast, Mr Sarafian Salleh, also known as Tuah Bugis, as he shares about the lives of the Bugis community.
