

Enhanced trail at Rail Corridor (Central)

The trail along Rail Corridor (Central) has been strengthened to improve its inclusiveness and durability.

<p>Previously, the trail would become muddy, difficult to access and rutted after a downpour.</p>  <p><i>Trail before enhancement works</i></p>	<p>The 4.5-metre-wide trail has been strengthened and sloped to allow rainwater to drain to the sides.</p> <p>Along more natural areas, the trail is kept rustic with a grass and gravel finish.</p>  <p><i>Strengthened trail with grass and gravel</i></p>
 <p><i>Trail before enhancement works</i></p>	<p>Along more urban areas where more residents tend to enter the Rail Corridor, the trail is finished with earth-coloured porous binded aggregates material to allow safe and comfortable access to users of different ages and abilities.</p> <p>This porous material allows rainwater to seep into ground quickly, thereby doing away with the need to construct drains on both sides of the trail, which may alter the natural character of the place.</p>
