#### **GastroBeats**

As the Festival Village of i Light Singapore, GastroBeats is a month-long celebration of good food, good music and good fun that brings the community together and showcases the diversity of local culture.

Foodies can indulge in delicacies served up by 50 homegrown F&B vendors, featuring both classic and modern dishes to tantalise their taste buds. Music lovers are also in for a treat with live performances by talented local musicians from a variety of genres, such as 53A and Tabula. In addition, fun seekers are sure to be delighted by the array of activities, such as towering bouncy castles for both the young and young-atheart.

At the DBS Zone, visitors can enjoy a variety of interactive experiences and instagrammable visual installations, designed around the themes of self-care, sustainable living and being future-ready. Children can learn about money matters at POSB Money Smarts through experiences designed to stimulate their creativity, while adults can test their reflexes at interactive games Money Matchmaker and Made for Travel. Visitors can also try their hands at rowing machines to light up an installation at Eco Row and Glow, or work the camera at Find Your Spark where a glambot will help capture cinematic, slow-motion video reels.

General admission to the Festival Village is free, while charges apply for selected activities. More information on GastroBeats can be found here.

Lightwave: Turning the Tide, presented by Alibaba Cloud

### i Light i Pledge, presented by Alibaba Cloud

This year, the Festival is once again partnering susGain, a local social enterprise championing sustainability, on *i Light i Pledge*. The public is encouraged to pledge their commitment to eco-conscious practices by making small but impactful changes in their daily lifestyles to cultivate sustainable habits.

They can do so through two separate pledges:

- The **Switch Off, Turn Up** (**SOTU**) pledge calls for all to switch off non-essential lightings and turn up air-conditioning temperatures during and beyond the festival period. Since the Festival's inception in 2010, SOTU has been a key component of i Light Singapore's sustainability drive. The initiative has rallied many building owners, corporations and businesses around and beyond Marina Bay to reduce their energy consumption in lighting and air-conditioning. This year, over 100 buildings and properties will be participating in the initiative (see list of participants <u>here</u>). The programme has also been extended to the public and schools for the first time this year.
- The **Be a Zero Hero** pledge encourages the public to adopt zero waste habits such as reducing the use of single-use items and food waste.

For each pledge submitted by participants up to the first 5,000 pledges, All Clear – a sustainability enterprise providing offshore and ocean clean-ups – will remove 100g of waste from Singapore waterways. As such, up to 500 kg of waste will be removed as an outcome of the pledge. The public can take part in *i Light i Pledge here* and stand to win attractive prizes.

For each pledge submitted online, a visual that is unique to each pledge, will be generated using Alibaba Cloud's AI technologies. The visuals can be viewed on *i Light i Pledge*'s website and as part of the last chapter at *Lightwave: Turning the Tide*. This initiative aims to demonstrate how a small step taken by an individual can contribute to a larger sustainability objective.



#### **Light Forum**

*Light Forum* is a curated series of talks, workshop and walking tours taking place on the first weekend of the Festival.

**Talks (3 June and 4 June):** Hear from lighting designers and experts from Singapore and abroad, as they share their ideas on sustainability, the future of nightscapes, and the transformative power of lighting and light art to shape the environments we live and work in. Artists behind the i Light Singapore artworks will also be present at selected sessions to share about their inspirations.

**Workshop (4 June):** Visitors can participate in a workshop on 4 June for a hands-on opportunity to light up a small-scale facade of a building model, with guidance from professional exterior lighting experts.

Add-on tours (3 June and 4 June): As an optional add-on, *Light Forum* participants can also sign up for a walking tour held in partnership with Let's Go Tour Singapore. On this tour, they can hear from experienced guides the inspiration behind this year's Festival theme, A New Wave, as well as stories behind the light art installations. The tour is available to *Light Forum* participants at a discounted rate of SGD15/pax.
