

CONCEPTUAL PLANS FOR FORMER KEPPEL GOLF COURSE

The first housing parcel at the former Keppel golf course site is slated for launch within the next five years. This will kickstart the longer-term transformation of the Greater Southern Waterfront into a new major mixed-use gateway where Singaporeans can enjoy living, working and playing along the southern coast. The 48-hectare site will have about 9,000 new homes, including approximately 6,000 public housing units.

Future residents of the new estate at the former Keppel golf course site will enjoy living amid nature, with access to close to 10-hectare of green recreational spaces within the site and several nature areas nearby such as the Labrador Nature Reserve, Southern Ridges and the upcoming Berlayer Creek Nature Park. Residents will also enjoy the view of greenery at their doorstep as housing blocks will feature staggered building heights that will step down towards the green spaces.

The future residential estates will also be well-connected to the Telok Blangah and Labrador Park MRT stations, enabling residents to easily access the transport nodes. For example, cycling paths will be built along the roads to provide seamless connection between the residential developments and the MRT stations.
