



RUNWAY FOR YOUR IMAGINATION

The Runway “Kris”: Weaving Future Community with Themed Parkway

From Static-city to Fluid-city

The overall design idea reinforces the genius loci of the runway, inspired by aerodynamics (flow, movement and force) generated from aircraft landing and take-off, vehicle taxiing and moving, machines loading and operating, equipment automation, wind and sound of the weather, as well as human circulation patterns.

The vision of the Paya Lebar master plan is to transform a “Static-city to become a “Fluid-city”, where through the confluence and integration of infrastructural layers, convergence and divergence in spatial organization, crossroads and criss-crossing of developments, they are woven together to form a unique “Kris” pattern. This dynamic master plan layout captures the site’s character and spirit, the industrial essence and atmosphere, extending the legacy and memories of the Paya Lebar Airbase to link its past, present and future together.




Paya Lebar Tomorrow: Runway for a Dynamic City


Positioning PLAB as a future Regional Centre



HORIZON – A Living Memorial to Commemorate Aviation Memories

Adopting a hedonistic approach in design, our proposal – The Horizon – aims to reinvent Paya Lebar airbase runway into a memorial-cum-elevated viewing platform. Bustling with exciting programs and public amenities, the proposed intervention is envisioned to be Singapore’s next landmark as well as a tribute to the site’s aviation history.



The “S” City – Shared, Small, and Sensitive

A celebration of the past, present and future of the Paya Lebar Airbase - Flexel Studio

Embracing values of sharing, small interventions, and being sensitive, this proposal transforms the Paya Lebar Runway into an agricultural park, and, on its adjacent lands, aims to create a prosperous, resilient, vibrant, and creative community with a distinctive identity that ties closely into the global network while maintaining local relevance and connections

The master plan 1) Embraces the “swampy” history of the site by introducing an estuarine habitat that links the Serangoon River to two existing reservoirs nearby


2) Commemorates the production of palm plantations in the old days by transforming the runway into an agricultural park

3) Celebrates the legacy of the Paya Lebar Airbase by preserving the runway outline, and by creating a cultural district based on the major airport facility buildings.

Ultimately it aims to create a prosperous, resilient, and vibrant community with a distinctive identity of its own

The Runway “Sheds” Re-purposing of Airport Heritage Buildings

The Runway “Sheds” is the design concept of revamp, using a series of new components and extensions that integrate with the Former Paya Lebar Airport Building Complex, emphasizing the idea of a light-touch approach by anchoring the old permanent buildings with new transient forms of architecture providing flexibility and adaptability.
