Urban farming and food gardening are healthy and active forms of recreation. Drop by the OCBC Urban Garden to meet our green advocates who champion local produce as a sustainable food resource. Key highlights include a see-through composting tank that provides first-hand view of an anaerobic method of composting.

Organisation Name	Description
OCBC Urban Garden	Get up close with an anaerobic and odourless way of composting at the OCBC Urban Garden. In a large see-through tank filled with food waste, the public can learn first-hand about food waste management and urban gardening. This showcase is supported by OCBC Bank and managed by OCBC volunteers, in collaboration with students and teachers of Yu Neng Primary School. Members of the public are able to collect free

	compost for their personal use. Seeds and pots are available for sale at <i>eco.me</i> .
Singapore Polytechnic	A group of students from Singapore Polytechnic will be displaying their rotating "urban farming kit" that resembles a Ferris wheel and allows more plants to be grown in a given space. The system is devised by a team of four aeronautical engineering students and comes with an automatic irrigation system.
UGrowGardens	Learn about different composting systems – the Bokashi, the Black Soldier Fly, the Earthworm from green farming experts such as James Lam, Founder of UGrowGardens. There will also be a vertical vegetable growing system showcase to demonstrate how it is possible to cultivate green in small spaces that is hassle-free and budget-friendly.
Greenology	A showcase on new technologies in urban sustainability and on the role of respect in developing new urban ecologies –termed 'Bio-filial' implying one's filial duty to the environment.
