

# 79 - 109 JELlicOE ROAD

These 16 shophouses were built in the late 1920s by Heinrich Rudolf Arbenz, a Swiss architect and civil engineer. The Art Deco style is evident through the use of geometric shapes in the design of the balconies as well as the brackets below them. Unlike most shophouses that have roofs that slope to the front and rear, the two-storey shophouses have gable roofs that together create a rare zig-zag roof line.

Previously occupied by engineering and motor workshops, hardware shops and other industrial related businesses, the shophouses have since been sensitively restored and transformed into high-end townhouses.
