The Olson Building of the Former Methodist Girls' School, the oldest building on the site, was designed by Frank Wilmin Brewer in 1928. Careful attention has been given to remove paintwork over the original fair-faced brickwork, while salvaged materials such as door hinges and roof tiles have been integrated into the site.

At the Former Trinity Theological College Chapel, extra effort has been taken to restore the original floor and wall finishes. Originally made of acrylic, the “stained glass” feature by the entrances were carefully replicated with glass due to fire safety requirements.

The Former Nan Hwa Girls' High School features the reinstated plaster moulding bearing the school's name and restored memorial plaque marking the opening of the school in 1941.
