

**Request for Proposal process (July 2016 to 3Q2017)**

***Stage 1 – Pre-Qualification (8 weeks from July 16 to September 16)***

Interested teams are required to submit information on their team composition and organisation, track record, as well as a Statement of Planning and Design Intent and Approach.

The Statement of Planning and Design Intent and Approach should include an analysis of key challenges involved in the master planning of Jurong Lake District, and suggested approaches to creatively overcome them. It should also highlight the approach towards achieving the vision and goals for Jurong Lake District as 'A District of the Future' and Singapore's second CBD. The submissions must be made to URA by 5 September 2016.

In September 2016, up to five teams will be shortlisted to participate in Stage 2 of the RFP.

***Stage 2 – Developing the Concept Master Plan (10 weeks from September 16 to December 16)***

The shortlisted teams will participate in a 10 week exercise to develop their Concept Master Plans. The submissions must be made to URA by 7 December 2016.

The appointed team will be notified in January 2017.

***Post RFP – Developing the Draft Master Plan, public exhibition and refinement of Draft Master Plan (24 weeks from February 17 to 3Q2017)***

The appointed team will work with URA and partner agencies to draw up a detailed Jurong Lake District Draft Master Plan.

The public exhibition of the Draft Master Plan will be held around 3Q2017, and the public will be invited to give their feedback.

Thereafter, the appointed team will work with URA to refine the Draft Master Plan, taking into account the feedback received from the public, stakeholders, partner agencies, and the Jurong Lake District Steering Committee.
